



TTCC-SPONSORED CKC AGILITY TRIAL

Dream Fields, Ottawa, Ontario
October 10 and 11, 2009

On October 10 and 11, the Tibetan Terrier Club of Canada hosted its fourth (and third consecutive) all-breed agility trial. Once again, owners and handlers loved the trial and were outspoken in their appreciation. A total of 76 individual dogs entered the trial, most of whom made up to six different 'runs' each, for a total of more than 300 runs. All performance levels were offered—Novice, Intermediate and Excellent in Standard and Jumpers With Weaves—and at all heights.



It was exciting that six Tibetan Terriers participated in the trial:

- Majka and Hynek Broulik's **Mungo** who earned an Intermediate Q.
- Penny White's **Fiesta** who finished her Novice Title and then Intermediate courses.
- Penny's 19-month-old **Maddie**, Fiesta's daughter, who earned a Q in her debut at a Canadian Kennel Club trial.
- Penny's **Amaia**, grande dame of Canadian Agility, who kicked off the Veterans' Commemorative Event.
- Linda Milbrath travelled from Wisconsin to complete with **Echo**, who earned a Novice Title, and **Zoe**.
